The start/finish line will be off OYC Docks 5 and 6 (but slightly farther west), and courses will round buoys between Jack London Square and Coast Guard Island.

Cost: Only \$100 (\$110 after Dec, 31, 2019) for the whole series and \$20 for each single race. Register online at [Jibeset](#), or entry forms are available on the [OYC website](#) under the racing tab or at the OYC clubhouse front desk.

One design fleets of four or more entries may have separate starts. Separate start for non-spinnaker boats. PHRF time-on-distance handicaps will be used.

All monohull yachts must have a NCPHRF certificate, and multihull yachts must have a BAMA rating certificate. The certificate is to be for the current year or 1 year prior. One Single Race (SR) entry per boat, per series, will be accepted without the PHRF Certificate.

Two throw-outs allowed.

Races will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020, and OYC sailing instructions.

Sailing Instructions and Course Sheets will be available no later than 01/3/19 on [Jibeset](#), on the OYC [website](#) under the racing tab, and at the OYC clubhouse. Preliminary fleet assignments will be available by 1200 hours on Jan 4, 2019. Late entrants will be assigned to fleets for best fit with existing divisions. However, if late entries create a one-design fleet, the race committee will make every effort to establish a one-design start.

OYC Sunday Brunch served 0900-1200.

Interesting pre-race presentations: Kame Richards, topic to be decided; Angelo Perata: "Cold Water Immersion;" Ted Keech, "What If You Knew Who Would Win the Protest before the Occurrence Even Happened?" and perhaps one or two other speakers as well.
